

Victim Support Services

The Violence Intervention Program (VIP)

supports primary and secondary victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, and violent crimes. Services include a 24-hour hotline, individual and group counseling, one-on-one support at police stations, courts, and hospitals, and help in completing crime victim compensation claims. All services are free and confidential.

Emergency Shelter is available to victims seeking to leave an unsafe, abusive situation. The safe house is staffed 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and is wheelchair accessible.

Transitional Housing offers short-term housing assistance and supportive services for victims of violence who are homeless due to fleeing an abusive situation. Assistance is provided to establish new housing.

Education is available to primary and secondary schools, colleges, businesses, and community groups upon request. Specialized training is available for law enforcement and court personnel. VIP also coordinates volunteer training.

Emergency Housing Services

Emergency Shelter is available to homeless Otsego County residents. Eligible families may stay at the homeless shelter up to 90-days while they look for new, permanent housing. Temporary housing is also available at area motels on a case-by-case basis. *Opportunity House is a family-only shelter. Unsheltered individuals may call the 24-hour hotline for assistance.*

Support for New Parents

Building Healthy Families is a parent support service that begins during pregnancy or soon after birth and takes place in the comfort of home. Visitors assist parents to prepare for birth and parenting and partner with them to address stress and family challenges. They are trauma-informed and specially trained in brain development and infant mental health. Participation includes enjoyable family activities and can continue until Kindergarten.

Early Childhood Education

Early Head Start center-based programming is available in Oneonta for toddlers, ages 18 months to 3 years old. The program provides 12-month, full day, early learning, care and enrichment experiences to children and supports families through connections to community resources.

Employment Support

Wheels to Work offers financial assistance to eligible adults so they may make necessary vehicle repairs, obtain gas cards, and pay select DMV fees and car insurance premiums so they can get to and from work or job training programs. Applicants must live in Otsego County and be a parent or non-custodial parent of a minor child

Food & Nutrition Assistance

WIC provides monthly food benefits to eligible pregnant women, post-partum women, and families with children up to age 5. The program also offers extra support to breast feeding mothers, nutrition education, and referrals to community services. Fathers, grandfathers, foster parents, or other caregivers may apply on behalf of children under age five who are in their care. *Clinics in Oneonta and Cooperstown.*
